I am requesting funding for the Fort Laramie Canal Tunnel Restoration Project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is Bureau of Reclamation, Wyoming Area Office, located at 705 Pendell Blvd. Mills, WY 82644. The funding would be used for excavation of portal and canal transitions and for soil nails at Tunnels #1 and #2 of the Gering-Fort Laramie Canal. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the catastrophic collapse of the canal tunnels in 2019 left approximately 55,000 acres of farmland in Western Nebraska without necessary irrigation water and caused \$89 million in economic loss. And although the tunnels were temporarily repaired after the failure, they are at risk of another catastrophic failure in absence of an immediate, permanent repair. The project has a Federal nexus because it is authorized under 43 U.S.C Chapter 12, Subchapter XI-B, §510b (a).
