Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Ohiowa Well Replacement in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Village of Ohiowa, Nebraska located at P.O. Box 27 Ohiowa, NE 68416. The funding would be used for a well redrill and backup water supply well. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because The Village of Ohiowa's Public Water System Improvements project is a critical investment in the health, resilience, and sustainability of Nebraska's Third Congressional District. Serving approximately 120 residents, the Village relies on two wells for its public water supply. Following the failure of the backup well—despite significant repair efforts—and the deterioration of the existing well house, the Village now faces an urgent infrastructure need: the redrilling of a secondary well and construction of a new, codecompliant well house.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes described in 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
